Course Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safe working practices• Common fitting tools and engineering materials• The use of engineering drawings or symbols• Care and the correct use of mechanical measuring instruments• Measuring and marking out techniques and practice.• Thread types, fasteners and fixing devices.• Sharpening hand tools• Safe operational use bench/pedestal drilling machines and grinders• Knowledge and practical exercises incorporating: Filing, Drilling, Reaming, Tapping, Threading, Countersink and Counter boring• The 16 day course provides further practical exercises to enhance and assess practical skills and the application of knowledge to meet the required standards.• Each course may also be taken prior to other mechanical courses.
